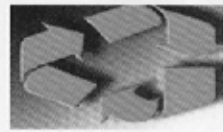

Lee County Recycles Right!

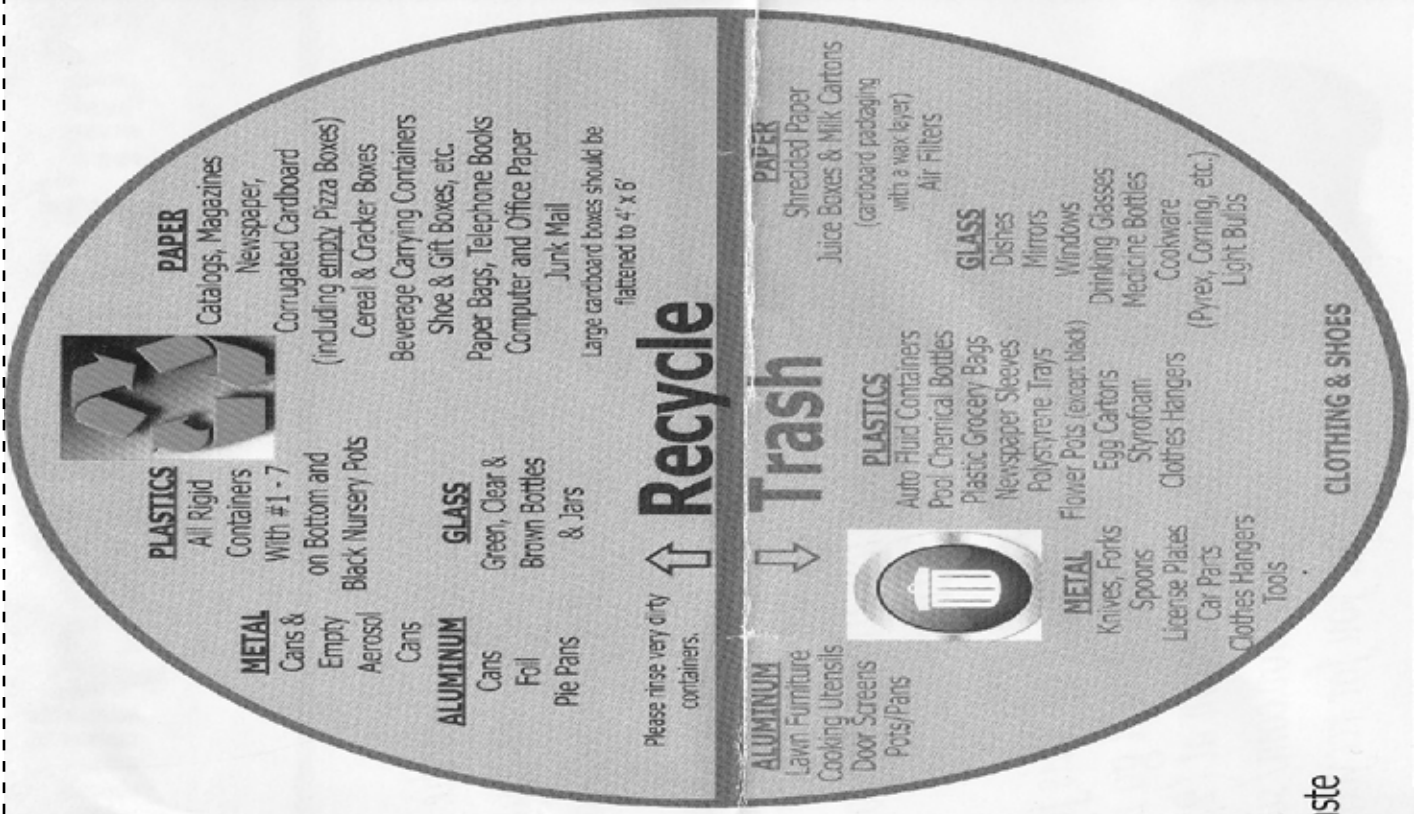
Please make sure your recycling container doesn't include any Dirty Culprits.

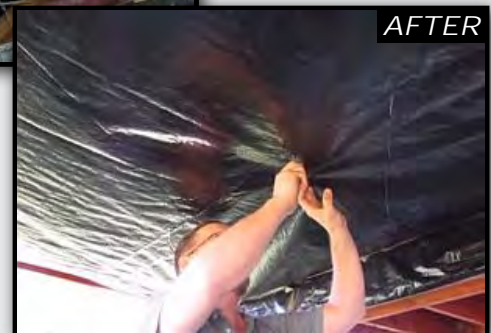

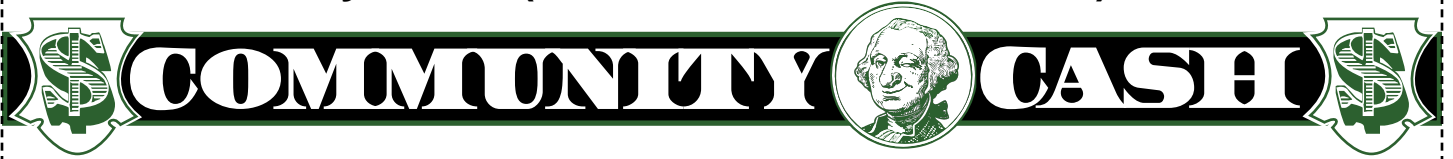
