




There are keys to many homes being held at the office. This practice is no longer available. Please contact the office to determine if a key to your home is there and obtain it before the end of January, 2020. We know some homes have new owners who may not be aware of this so it is important that all homeowners check this out.

REMINDERS from the Rules & Regulations ARTICLE IX PETS/ANIMALS

#3 Pets/Animals must not be left tethered outside unattended at any time. They shall not be allowed to run free.

#4 Pets/Animals must be on a leash no more than 6 feet in length (Lee County Law) and under control at all times when outdoors. They must be walked on paved streets or common areas only.

#5 It is the responsibility of the of the person walking the pet/animal to properly dispose of pet waste.

ARTICLE XVII MISCELLANEOUS

#4 Abusive or offensive language is prohibited in the Community.

#8 The discharge of firearms is prohibited anywhere in the Community.
