



Bartman, Greg Bartman, Billy Ray Caines, Bob Kusiak, Jim Kohany,




Frank Metzger, Gene Kelly and our maintenance man Randy Steiger. Again I want to thank all volunteers that helped to accomplish this project!

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#### **MY BUDDY**

I want to thank everyone for your love and support during this difficult time. Many of you didn't know Buddy, other than he was "Judy's Secretary." He used to tell people that when they called the house for me.

We were married for 69 years. It was a great ride with many twists and turns, but it was always fun. He was an avid bowler (inducted into the Greater Toledo Bowling Hall of Fame in 1995) and a gung-ho golfer; had a hole-in-one on the 5th at The Hideaway in 2008.

He was signed by the Cleveland Indians right out of high school and pitched for the Daytona Beach Islanders in the Florida State League along side his room mate, Rocky Colavito, and under the tutilege of Red Ruffing, no less. From there he went to the Cocoa Indians where he pitched a perfect game and, coincidently, where we met, (he chased me until I caught him). In 1952, the New York Giants drafted him and he played in their farm system until Uncle Sam came calling. He served two years in the Army. He was stationed at Selfridge Field near Detroit and although he was Army, the base commander recruited him to pitch for the Air Foce team and traveled with them during his tour there. However, when he came home his baseball career had essentially passed him by. In those days if you were more than 19 or 20 years old they weren't interested as they are today and the pay was terrible; nothing like today's megasalaries.

Always one to be his own boss, over the years we coowned Regal Lanes in Toledo, Ohio. He was recognized as the premier lane man in the NW Ohio area. His expertise was sought by many other lane managers whenever they had an upcoming tournament and needed a good, ABC spec condition. In those days everything was done by hand; no robot machines.

After Regal Lanes was sold, we purchased an auto electric company where his love of racing took hold. He and his partner built an "Indy" roadster and traveled the midwest with driver Leo Caldwell. In 1964 they were fortunate to win the Peach Blossom 200 in Atlanta and decided to quit while they were on top. I was happy too, I was no longer a "race widow."

He loved building things and we moved at least 14 times over the years. I would design the home and he would sub-contract the plumbing and electrical and do everything else himself. We never stayed in one place more than 3 or 4 years. I sure had packing down to a science!

We came to Lazy Days in 1999 as "snow birds" but in 2007 we decided to stay put and sold our lake property in Michigan to become full time residents on Leisure Lane. It has truly been the best years of our lives.
