As things begin to open up, we are anxiously trying to get back to normal. Some of our favorite restaurants and watering holes are open at 50% capacity; some only 25%, but still we should still practice social distancing. Wash your hands often and if you can find it, use hand sanitizer after opening doors, as handles are the most likely sources of contamination. Thankfully our Walmart, Publix, Sam's and others, are providing wipes when you enter so you can clean the cart handles. (I, personally, wear gloves and my mask when in the stores, just to be on the safe side.)

- Our little library is now open part time. The following is an excerpt from Patty's letter to the residents dated May 26, 2020:
- Hours are 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. Closed weekends.
- The area will be cleaned and sanitized each morning. We ask that, if possible, you please wear a mask.
- Residents ONLY are allowed in the library area. No guests or children allowed at this time.
- Limit of 2 people maximum at one time.
- Pick up and drop off ONLY. Please do not remain inside the library.
- The rest of the hall will still remain closed and will be blocked off.
- Residents will be using the facility at their OWN RISK.

Manager will be checking footage from the cameras so if rules are not being followed the Board will have the right to close the library again.

We ask you to please be considerate of other residents and limit your time in the library so that everyone who has the opportunity to go in may do so. This is your home and that of all your neighbors. We all want everyone to stay safe and healthy so we ask that you please abide by these rules.

I hope you are having a safe and fun summer so far. A few reminders of the rules and regulations of the park: No parking on any grass areas or on the streets; no overnight parking at the halls; speed limit in the park is 15mph.

The Board has discussed and agreed to extend the pool hours from 9:00am–9:00pm. Capacity will increase to 13 people which is the maximum bathing load. This will be effective Monday, June 22, 2020. Cleaning and disinfecting will continue to be done in the morning prior to opening, however, we ask that everyone please take ownership as well with disinfecting and cleaning. Please use towels or coverings on the chairs. Remember, we are all in this together.






