CLOSING UP FOR THE SUMMER

Some tips for closing your home for the summer:

- 1. Have a summer caregiver (key holder); provide that and other pertinent info to the office.
- 2. Forward your mail and make sure the office has a correct ADDRESS, PHONE AND EMAIL; leave a set of keys at the office if you want to do so.
- 3. Put away ALL outside items, including umbrella- type clotheslines. Small items can become missiles in a storm.
- 4. Unplug all electrical devises.
- 5. Make sure smoke alarms are working and have fresh batteries.
- 6. Turn your refrigerator/freezer off.
- 7. Put plastic wrap over toilet and tank to prevent water from evaporating.
- 8. If you leave air on, set it at 80-90° and put fresh batteries in your thermostat. If you have a humidistat, set it at 65°.
- 9. Clean or replace the air conditioning filter.
- 10. Turn water off.
- 11. Turn off water heater.
- 12. Close and lock all windows and doors securely.
- 13. Put your utilities on vacation or have shut off.
- 14. Lower and secure all awnings.
- 15. Spray for bugs and weeds; hire a commercial vendor.






