Dear Residents:

We are halfway through summer and have been lucky with the storm season so far. However, as we know, September through November can be unpredictable, so please make sure your hurricane supplies stay fully stocked.

New propane tanks were installed at both halls. Hot water and dryers in North Hall are now back on. Hot water in South Hall is also back on.

Current projects in place:

- Interior of the North Hall is still in the process of being painted. Hall remains closed at this time.
- County water utility project continues in the park. Underground tie in pipes from Idelway to Easy Street are being completed along Sun Up, Leisure and Roses. Fire hydrants are being installed and will be active as soon as work is completed.
- Sealcoating contract has been signed and target date to commence project will hopefully be end of August. More information will be sent once dates are confirmed.

We are all hoping everyone is able to return in the fall and activities can resume. It's been a long two years and I know we are looking forward to being together again with neighbors and friends.


for you to give the gift of life. Thanks.




