The Annual Shareholder meeting was held on January 20th. The 2022 proposed budget did not pass, therefore, the monthly maintenance fees will remain the same. New coupon books will be ordered to start March 1, 2022. If you are on autopay, you will not receive a coupon book. Fees are due on the first of each month and considered late if received after the 10th. A \$25 late fee will be applied.

As there are many more residents in the park this time of year, walking, biking, etc. it is imperative that you please follow the rules of the road within the community:

As you exit the park to turn left on Business 41, if there is a car ahead of you in the median going




south, please wait until they have moved on. There should be only one car at a time in the median. A second vehicle could block the vision of the first, and we don't want any accidents, do we!!


