#### Dear Residents,

Happy New Year! Hope this year is a WHOLE lot quieter. I've been busy in December, mostly with storm related issues and getting Lazy



Days ready for the New Year. Some of the things we've been concentrating on include:

- 1. Inspections of the homes in Lazy Days for hurricane damage and on-going repairs. Letters were sent to residents we have not heard from about their damage and what their intentions are if the homes are beyond repair. Please remember if you are removing your home, you need to register with the office and complete paperwork and post an escrow security deposit of \$3,500 with the Association prior to any home being removed.
- 2. FEMA came in November and took out the vegetation from the front ditch. That probably saved the Association thousands of dollars. They said their orders were to get the vegetation and debris out of the wet spots before they start picking up the other debris. Let's hope they don't forget us.
- 3. The volunteers who have been working so hard to clean up all the common areas and resident's yards deserve everyone's heartfelt thanks. They were invaluable to the Park.

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

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
