Hello, Lazy Days Residents

WOW another month has gone by in a blink! Things are already quite busy and I sure am noticing that with more of you coming "home" for the season, there are more

issues being raised here in the office. Of course, many of these items do not merit a compliance violation letter; rather a simple reminder of our Rules and Regulations. So here goes my little list of common issues for you to be aware of:

Dogs cannot be allowed to bark excessively even from within your home. If the noise of their barking is enough for your neighbor to hear while inside their home it is too much. Please be a good neighbor and keep your pet happy and quiet! **Section IX rule #6**

When taking you dog on a potty break please take them to the common areas before they start their business! If the pavement is hot you may have to carry them but you cannot let your pet pee or poop on another home owner's private property. Section IX #4

Bird feeders and other wildlife feeding. This is both an infraction of our rules and regulations and a Florida Wildlife infraction .Please DO NOT FEED any of the critters you may see in the park. The food stuffs lying around will lead to rat and other unwanted vermin. Section XVII #9

NO street parking at night. This is to ensure emergency vehicles have access to all homes on our narrow roads in the event they are needed. **Section X #6**

There is to be a special shareholder meeting on Thursday, **Nov 16th** and shareholders will be getting an information package prior to the meeting. Please send back in your Proxy if you cannot make the meeting. Your board needs your input. The ability to vote and shape your community is the most valuable part of being a shareholder. 





